


#### MESSAGE FROM SUPERINTENDENT

Mary Stewart of Greenup was awarded a red ribbon for her participation in the state style revue. She modeled her 4-H Club project.



Donald's prize was a fountain pen and pencil set. He had earlier won the county and district championships in the same contest.


County Agent Amos Tackett accompanied the nine Greenup County boys and girls. Mrs. Agnes Miller provided transportation to Lexington for the girls.




