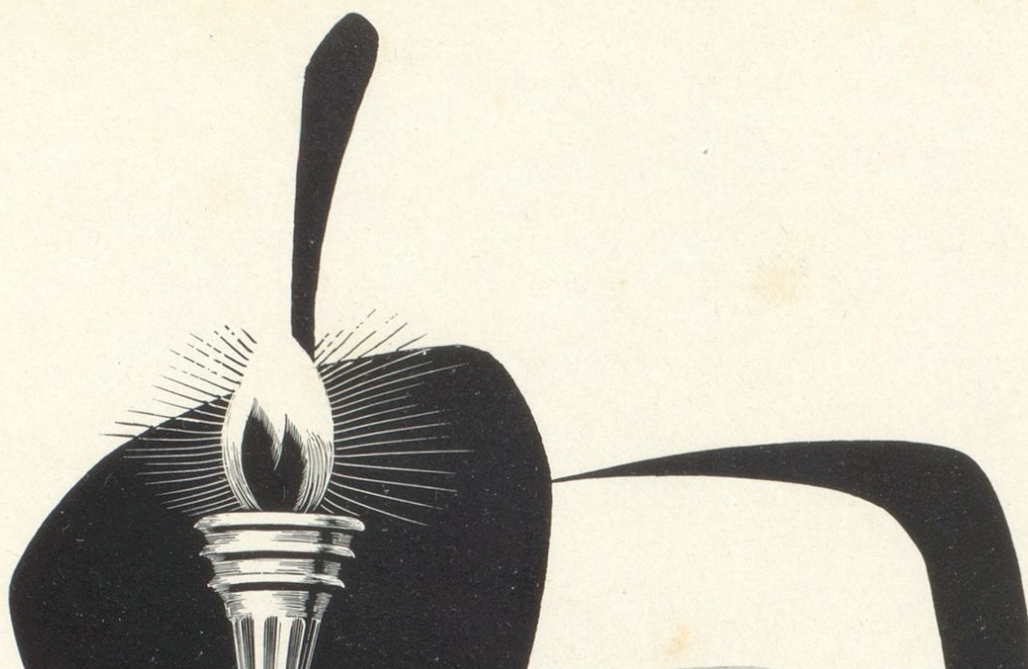

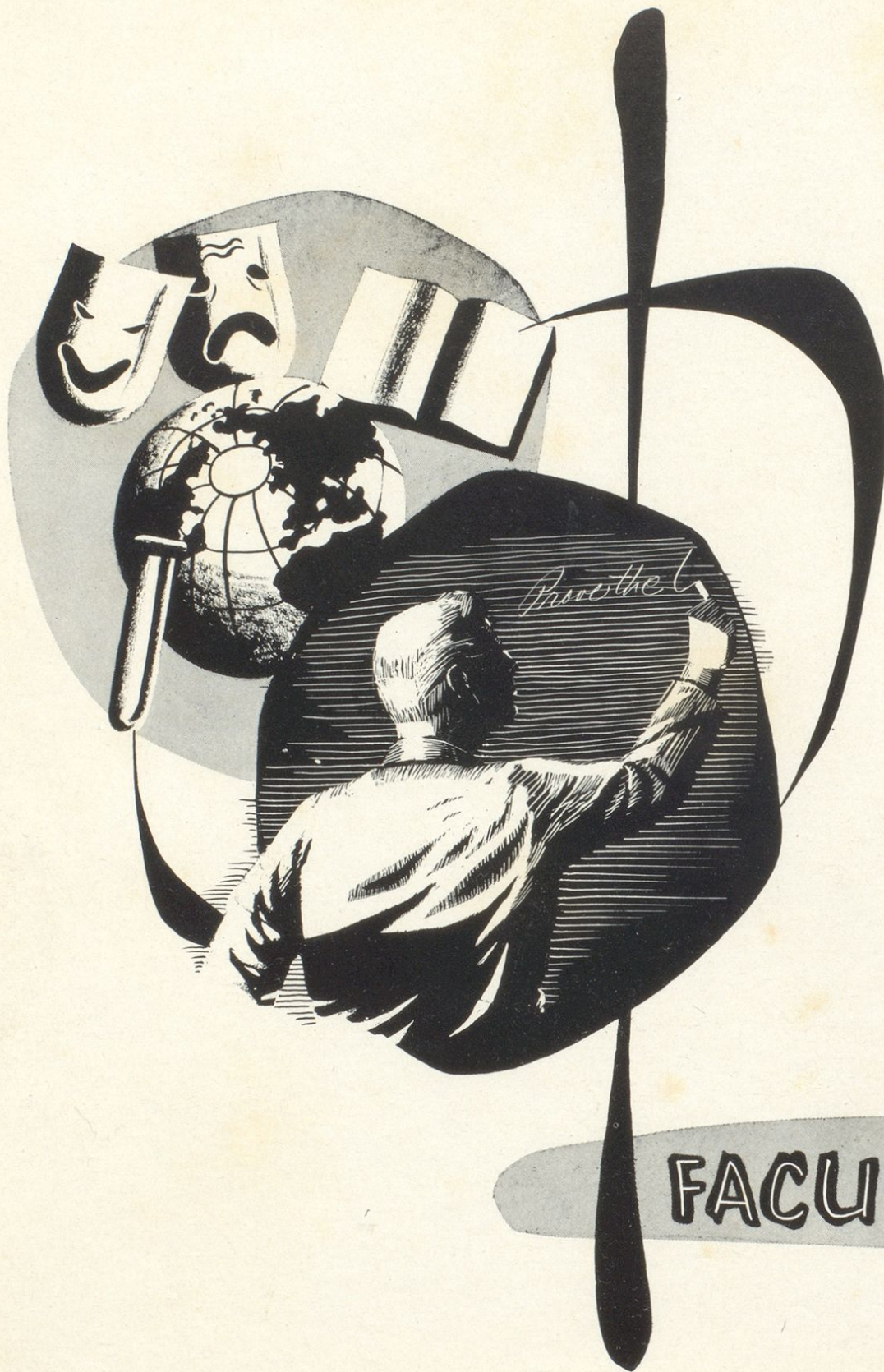

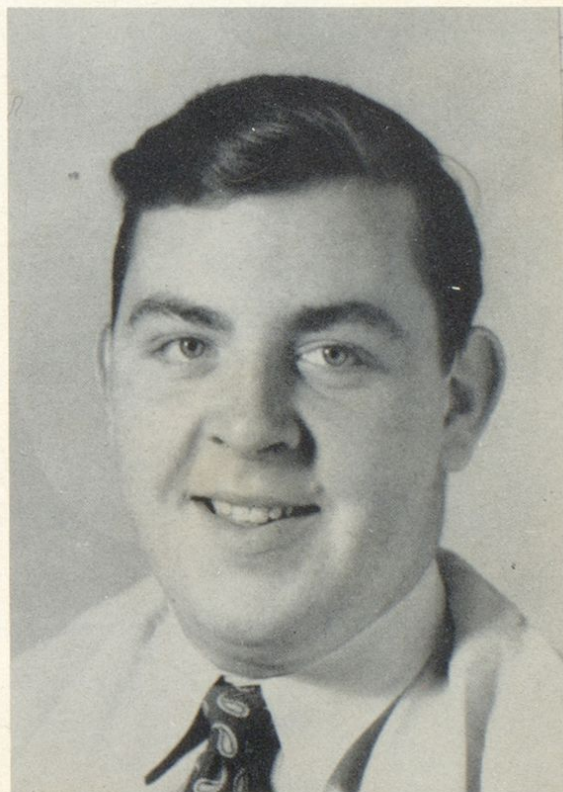
MESSAGE FROM SUPERINTENDENT

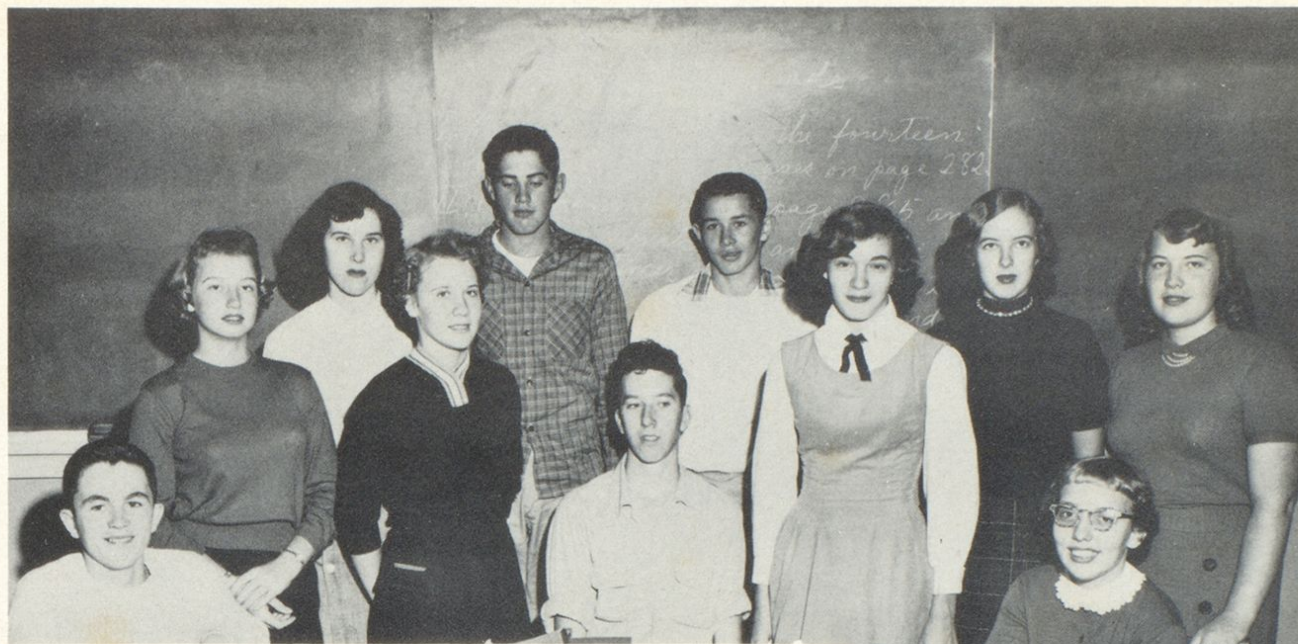
Greenup 4-H Club Gets Power Award

The word the 13-year-old youngster was eliminated on was "juxtaposition," relatively simple as compared with some of the words Wayne had spelled earlier.

Wayne slipped and began the word with a "g." He quickly realized his mistake, but it was too late. A rule declares that having started to spell a word, a contestant shall be given no opportunity to change letters once pronounced.

WASHINGTON, May 20 — Wayne Stephenson of Greenup, Ky., is the seventh best speller in the United States. The Herald-Dispatch entry in the National Spelling Bee finished in seventh place in a remarkable showing.

Wayne cheated himself out of a possible national championship by a slip of the tongue, going down on a word he knew perfectly well. It was one of those things that often happens under the pressure of national competition.
