Shirley McCubbin was elected cheerleader. We gave two assembly plays. We were an active class.

In the fall of 1950 we entered our sophomore year with a boom! Mrs. James Reed was our class sponsor. Charles Kegley was elected president and vice-president, and Avonelle Hannah was elected secretary and treasurer of the class. Phyllis McBrayer was our candidate for basketball queen. Soon we settled down and completed an excellent year of work and had many activities.

Naturally, it was a huge success. In fact, many critics say it was the best play ever staged in Greenup, Kentucky. That year, the boys in our class had an average height of 6' 1". Leo Oney, Bill Everman, Jesse Leadingham, and David Spurlock were on the basketball team. We gave the Seniors a festive banquet and prom with Don Burns' orchestra. It was a most memorable occasion. Our class members went to Morehead with the band and won first place in the district.

Now the members of our class of '52 are dignified Seniors, with our same sponsor, Mrs. Reed, and same class officers, except David Spurlock, who enlisted in the U.S. Air Force. We elected Avonelle Hannah as candidate for basketball queen. We had another big class play, "No Bride For The Groom." It was an immense hit. We, as a class, have been active in Beta Club, Rifle Club, Glee Club, Band, Streamliner, Annual, and the library. At present, in order to earn money for a class trip, we have a kitchen project. Shirley McCubbin has been elected the D.A.R. award winner. She deserves it.

This is the class which everyone has watched grow in work and pleasure, willing to do for each other.

It is time for this memorable class of '52 to say farewell. We have gone through chemistry, algebra, geometry, shorthand, and four years of English. We are now ready to wear our caps and gowns.

May the memories of this class live in the hearts of all our friends who return to G.H.S. next September.
